Greetings everyone.

Brush Dump: The dump / Transfer Station has taken quite a beating this year as we tried to leave it open without an attendant. Many people put their waste in the wrong containers and it appears that some didn't use the containers at all. The Public Works Dept. has had to spend almost every Monday cleaning up the mess from the weekends. In addition, an Islander recently informed me that they followed a truck with a large trailer full of stuff off the ferry and right to the transfer station where the trailer was emptied. Because of these abuses, we must react. Therefore, the transfer station will be open on Saturday from 10:00 AM until 2:00 PM only, and it will be attended. At all other times, as in the past, the gate will be left open enough to walk through so that household trash can be left in the containers. Please deposit your trash in the proper container. We will work this winter to develop a new policy for next year.



Monday Office Hours: As the season winds down, we are closing the office Mondays from now on. Please arrange your schedules accordingly.

Weekend meetings: There are a number of meetings this weekend. All of them will be held at the Fire Barn because of work being done on the lighting system at the community center. The first meeting will be with the Portland Water District to discuss, among other things, the septic tank limit for the Island. This meeting will be Friday at 1:00 PM and will be open to the public. Immediately following this meeting, the FII Board of Directors will have a meeting. On Saturday morning, at 8:00 AM there will be a special Selectmen / Executive Board meeting with the planning board to discuss the proposed growth ordinance. The Planning Board will hold a meeting at 8:30 AM. Both will be open to the public. Next Saturday, October 4th, the Selectmen / Board of Island Trustees executive committee will hold a special meeting to finalize the budget. In addition, there will be a public hearing to present the new: TOWN OF FRYE ISLAND, CIVIL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND PREPAR-EDNESS ORDINANCE. This meeting is planned for the Community Center, conditions permitting, at 9:00 AM. I will keep you posted.




