Island Manager's Comments

Greetings Everyone,

Labor Day traditionally marks the final busy weekend of the summer. It doesn't seem possible that the summer has come and gone already. This prompts a couple of reminders...

Ferry Schedule

The ferry schedule will revert to the post-season schedule after the weekend. Please make sure that you review the schedule to avoid any difficulties.

Boating

Many boat owners, including jet skiers, will be trying to spend as much time on the water as they can during this last weekend. I have received numerous complaints lately about watercraft, especially jet skis, speeding in and out of beach areas, including swim areas. I would like to remind everyone of the State laws pertaining to the use of watercraft around the shoreline of the lake.

- **Water Safety Zone:** "Water Safety Zone" means the area of water within 200 feet of any shoreline, whether the shoreline is of the mainland or of an island.
- **Swimming Area:** A motorboat shall not be operated in an area marked or buoyed for swimming.
- **Speed Regulations:** Watercraft may not be operated at a speed greater than headway speed while within a water safety zone.

Please operate your boats and jet skis responsibly; safely and *legally* to minimize the potential of inflicting personal injury upon yourself or another and to make sure that your summer doesn't end with a citation.

Budget Meeting

A meeting has been scheduled for **9:00 AM on Saturday morning, September 3**, for the initial presentation of the proposed budget to the property owners of Frye Island. This will not be the final iteration of the budget, but if you would like to provide input into the process this will be an opportunity to do so.

FII Board Meeting

Sunday, September 4, 2005, at 8:00 PM

The purpose of the meeting is to discuss and receive feedback from FII stockholders on a proposed motion to be voted on at the October 8 FII Stockholder's Meeting. This motion, in its current draft form is as follows:

MOTION: The FII stockholders endorse the FII Board's intent to sell up to three waterfront lots, with the expenditure of the net proceeds after legal costs and possible taxes being restricted to the buyback of a larger number of privately held, buildable inland lots. Such bought-back lots will then be placed in conservation. The overall objective of this undertaking is to reduce the ultimate total

number of houses on the island and the impacts of all of these houses on the Island infrastructure.

The Board intends to sell one lot to start and then effectively exhaust the buyback fund created thereby before going on to sell the next one.

The Board will further attempt to minimize taxes by coupling the sale of each lot with the buyback purchase of others under Title 26, Section 1031 of the U.S. Tax Code regarding the exchange of property.


