Island Manager's Comments

Greetings Everyone,

Ferry Schedule: We are now into the Post-Season schedule. Please make sure that you review the schedule to avoid any difficulties. The schedule for the second ferry is subject to change during this time period depending on traffic demands so please make your plans based on the first ferry schedule during the week. Weekend operation for the second ferry will continue as scheduled.

Budget: I want to thank everyone that attended the budget presentation held last weekend. There were many positive comments that will be evaluated for possible inclusion into the final budget which will be presented at the Town meeting on Saturday, October 8.

Dogs, Dogs, Dogs: I have been getting a number of complaints about dogs running loose on the beaches. I know that it is quite late in the season to bring this up, but everyone should be considerate of fellow Islanders using the public beaches. No one wants to be accosted by a wet dog or be endangered by angry dogs on the beach. Remember, the State of Maine has a leash law and anyone disregarding this law is subject to a fine and removal of your pet by the Animal Control Officer.

Maine Residents: The State of Maine is embarking on a promotional campaign to inform Maine residents about the "Maine Residents Property Tax and Rent Refund Program." Eligibility is based on household income. A guidance document on household income is available at the office or online at www.maine.gov/revenue/taxrelief. Have a safe and sunny weekend!
