Town News

Island Manager's Comments

Greetings everyone:

It hardly seems possible that the season is almost over. I hope everyone enjoyed the season and has a safe and healthy winter.

Meetings: The following meetings have been scheduled: Board of Selectmen / Executive Committee – Saturday October 18th at 9:00 AM in the administration Office.

Town Meeting: The Town Meeting was held last weekend. Prior to the meeting we issued 166 voting packets for the Board of Island Trustees and 40 packets for registered town voters. I thought it was a great turnout that generated a lot of discussion on the articles.

The following people were elected to office:

- Selectman – Jim Kuiken
- Executive Committee – Dave Bond and Joe Potts
- School Board Director – Oleg Svetlichny

The warrant is available on our web site if you would like to review it. With the exception of **Article 7**, all of the articles passed.

Article 7, an article to raise and appropriate \$50,000 through taxes for the Ferry Capital Reserve, failed.

Failure of article 7 triggered the options available in article 8 to determine the cost of ferry tickets for the 2009 season. By written ballot, 85 for – 25 against, the cost of a ferry ticket will be \$30.00. However, tickets purchased at the office will receive a 50% discount. In other words, if anyone purchases a ferry ticket at the ferry trailer on the mainland the cost of a ticket will be \$30.00. If anyone purchases a ferry ticket in the Town office the cost of a ticket will be \$15.00 (minimum 5, maximum 20). The cost to transport construction vehicles will be as listed on the price schedule which is also available on our web site.

Elections: I am sure that everyone is aware that the State and Federal elections are coming November 4th. The polls will open at the Community Center at 10:00 AM and remain open until 8:00 PM. The ferry will run until 9:00 PM to insure that everyone that would like to vote in person will have the opportunity.

Absentee ballots are available in the office for those that will not be able to vote in person..

Island Closing: The last ferry for the public will run at 9:00 PM on Tuesday November 4th. The last day to do business in the office will be Monday November 3rd.

Code Officer: The final day for the Code Officer will be Thursday October 30th. If you have business with the CEO or anticipate questions for the next season make sure you see him before the office closes on the 30th.

Long Beach Marina: I have scheduled to have the docks removed on Saturday November 1st. Please make sure that your boat is off the docks by then.

Have a very safe, health and enjoyable winter.

A special thanks to Ronnie Ilich for her wonderful work as the Administration Ferry Clerk, Ronnie saved the Town and myself several hours of work.


