Island Manager's Comments

Greetings Everyone: It hardly seems possible that the season is almost over. I hope everyone enjoyed the season and has a safe and healthy winter. This will be the final edition of the FINS for the season.

Meetings: The following meetings have been scheduled: Board of Selectmen / Executive Committee – Saturday October 17th at 9:00 A.M. in the Administration Office.

Town Meeting: The Town Meeting was held last weekend. Prior to the meeting we issued 107 voting packets for the Board of Island Trustees and 25 packets for registered town voters.

The following people were elected to office:

- Selectman – John Nun
- Executive Committee – H. Bob Sutherland

The warrant is available on our web site if you would like to review it. All of the articles passed.

Elections: I am sure that everyone is aware by now that the State Referendum election will be held on Tuesday, November 3rd. The polls will open at the Ferry Trailer at 10:00 AM and remain open until 8:00 PM. All of the ballots including the absentee ballots will be counted immediately after the polls close.

Absentee ballots are available in the office for those that will not be able to vote in person.

Contact Information: One final request for current emergency contact information. If you have changed your e-mail address or off island phone number or have not supplied it please send it to me at wfournier@fryeisland.com. Without this information it is very difficult to inform Islanders of issues on the Island during the off season.

Island Closing: The last ferry for the public will run at 7:00 PM on Monday November 2nd. The Town Office will be closed Tuesday October 27th through Thursday October 29th so that we can move the office to the Ferry trailer for the winter. The office will reopen on Friday, October 29th and Saturday, October 31st at the Ferry Trailer. The last day to do business in the office will be Saturday October 31st. However, our resources will be limited and the trailer will be congested so please try to conduct all of your business prior to that final weekend. If you need to re-register a vehicle or a trailer remember that you can do it on line. Also, if you want to re-register your boat this can be done on line as well after the first of the year.

Code Officer: The final day for the Code Officer will be Thursday October 22nd. If you have business with the CEO or anticipate questions for the next season make sure you see him before the office closes on the 22nd.

Long Beach Marina: I have scheduled to have the docks removed on Saturday October 31st. Please make sure that your boat is off the docks by then.


