## Island Manager's Comments

### Greetings everyone:

**Town Meeting:** The annual Town Meeting was held last Saturday. There were 141 BIT voters and 69 Town voters at the meeting. The results of the meeting are summarized below:

- Article 1:** John Crosby was elected moderator of the meeting.
- Article 2:** Celeste Beaulieu was elected to a 3 year term as Selectwoman
- Article 3:** Gary Donohue was re-elected to a 3 year term on the Executive Committee.
- Article 4:** The budget passed as presented. A copy will be made available on the Frye Island website and in the office.
- Article 5:** Passed establishing semi annual tax payments for 2013 due on December 31 2012 and June 30 2013.
- Article 6:** Passed establishing a 7% interest rate on delinquent taxes.
- Article 7:** Passed authorizing the Selectmen and Treasurer to sell tax acquired property.
- Article 8:** Passed authorizing the Selectmen and Treasurer to accept and expend gifts and donations outside the approved budget.
- Article 9:** Passed authorizing the Selectmen and Treasurer to accept and expend State and Federal grants.
- Article 10:** Passed authorizing the Selectmen to expend funds from the designated reserves for their designated purposes in accordance with the amended Town Charter, Article VII, Section 9. These expenditures can be reflected outside of the approved budget.
- Article 11:** Passed directing the Executive Committee to video or audio record Executive Committee meetings, town meetings, special town meetings, and public hearings and to post them on the website within 14 days of the meeting starting in 2014.
- Article 12:** Passed authorizing an additional \$37,500 over and above the Town budget to fund EMS coverage during the Pre & Post seasons.
- Article 13:** Passed authorizing the Executive Committee to borrow up to \$150,000 to construct a new municipal building. The loan to be paid for from the General Fund Balance.
- Article 14:** Passed reserving 1601 & 1602 as future beaches. Frye Island Inc. will retain ownership of these properties.
- Article 15:** Passed accepting 266 lots as gifts from Frye Island Inc.
- Article 16:** Approved the new ordinance entitled "Town of Frye Island Solid Waste Ordinance".
- Article 17:** Article 17 was withdrawn with unanimous consent.
- Article 18:** Was approved to appropriate up to 20,000 from the Long Term Transportation Reserve to continue the process to acquire the permit for the ring road project.

**Article 19:** Article 19 was to appropriate up to \$15,000 for the ring road permit but was tabled in light of the passage of article 18.

**Article 20:** To establish an Ad Hoc committee to participate in the search process for a new Town Manager did not pass.

**Article 21:** Passed authorizing the appropriation of an additional \$13,000 to apply "Cedar Shake" style vinyl siding on the Administration/ store building.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:50 PM. The full text of the articles is available on the Frye Island website.

**State & National Election:** The State referendum election will be held on Tuesday, November 5th. The polls will be open at the Ferry Trailer on the mainland from 10:00AM until 8:00 PM. Absentee ballots are now available in the Town Office for those registered voters unable to vote in person. *Please take note, the law changed last year and we can not issue absentee ballots after the close of the office on Thursday October 31<sup>st</sup>. In order to get an absentee ballot after that date you need to get a special exception from the State.*

**Office Closure:** We are rapidly approaching the end of the season. As you know we have to move the office operation, including the computer equipment to the ferry trailer. We plan to do this during the week of October 21st. **Saturday October 19<sup>th</sup> will be the last day we are open on the Island.** It may seem a bit early but we need to get everything moved and running before the elections are held on November 5<sup>th</sup> and it is not unusual to experience start-up problems every time we make this move.

**Long Beach Marina:** Because the water level is decreasing very quickly, we had to get the docks at the Long Beach Marina out sooner than expected. There are still a few left. If your boat is still there please get it out this weekend the remaining docks will be removed next week.

**FINS:** This will be the final FINS publication for the season. I would like to thank all of the Town employees and the many volunteers that worked throughout the season to make the Island the great place that we all enjoy.

**Meeting Reminder: Executive Committee Meeting:** The next meeting of the Board of Selectmen / Executive Committee has been scheduled for Saturday October 19<sup>th</sup> at 8:00AM.
