Island Manager's Comments

Softball Tournament and Dedication

USS Zumwalt Day

This coming Saturday the Island will be hosting the crew and families of this new class of destroyer. I have had the pleasure of meeting the Captain and some of the Chiefs. This is a true team of professionals. Let's all try to make this a fun day for those who serve our country and their families.

Office Hours

Effective August 2nd 2014, the office will be closed on Tuesdays for training.

The Treasurer Wayne Fournier and Assistant Town Clerk Lisa Kerrigan will be working together to train the New Town Manager and Town Clerk on all of Frye Island's procedures and protocols. We have waited until after the busy season in the office to do this training. Please be patient, there is a great deal of information and records to learn and digest.

Ferry Tolls

It has been brought to my attention that a few island residents are not replenishing their ferry accounts after they are triggered by email for a low balance. I urge all residents to add an "ACH" account for this purpose. It takes all the thinking out of the process. For those of you residents that refuse to do the automatic replenishment, it becomes your own responsibility to replenish by mail or a visit to the office. Presently we have Islanders who are in arrears in their accounts. This is not acceptable practice or fair to the responsible island residents and families.

Effective on August 1, 2014 there will be no passage on the ferry if your account balance is below your toll fare. The vehicle or passenger will be charged at Tier 3 rates with no exception.

The Captains, mates, and all other ferry employees have been advised of this change. I would also appreciate the islanders to treat our employees with the respect that they have earned and deserve. If anyone has a complaint about the policy change I am certainly willing to hear their thoughts.

NIXLE: Our NIXLE system is up and running. This system will notify all subscribers of important / emergency notices in their

selected areas via text, web, and email. The best part of this is that it is a free service to both the municipality and to residents as well. We can initiate notices to all Islanders that subscribe to the service. However, in order to access the notices you will be required to subscribe. You can subscribe by going to their website at www.nixle.com and following the prompts. A test notice was sent yesterday to those that have enrolled. I would encourage everyone to subscribe to this service. It is an ideal way to be notified of issues that may affect your time on the Island.

Internet Access: A number of Islanders have inquired about possibility of getting internet access at the Community Center and we do have Wi-Fi there. It is presently a secure connection but if the Community Center is open, you can get the password from the person there.

Real Estate Taxes were due 6/30/14. If you have not paid your second half payment please do so as soon as possible. 30 Day notices will be sent out on August 22 with the lien process to follow. Please save the town a lot of time and money and pay your taxes promptly before this process begins. Thank you.

We have already received the fall seasonal from Sebago brewing, Bonfire Rye, and should receive the immensely popular Smashed Pumpkin from Shipyard next week. More great beers to sample! Our beer event schedule is coming into focus and we will be having a Sebago Brewing tap takeover on Saturday August 23. In addition to our best selling Frye's Leap IPA, we will be featuring other fine brews from Sebago Brewing. A brewer's rep will be onsite and I am sure that there will be swag to go around!
