However, in order to access the notices you will be required to subscribe. You can subscribe by going to their website at www.nixle.com and following the prompts. A test notice was sent yesterday to those that have enrolled. I would encourage everyone to subscribe to this service. It is an ideal way to be notified of issues that may affect your time on the Island.
