Ferry

There will be additional hours for the second ferry on Sunday morning during high season beginning June 28th and ending September 6th. The second ferry will start at 10:00am instead of noon.

Park & Ride Appeal

The permit that was issued in April for the Park and Ride by the Planning Board for the Town of Raymond has been appealed by a group of aggrieved parties from both Raymond and Frye Island. I have requested our Webmaster to post this document for all interested parties.

As of 6/10/15, all brush brought to the Transfer Station shall not exceed 5 foot in total length. Brush longer than 5 foot will be turned away.

Town Office Hours

The office will be open Tuesday thru Saturday from 9 am to 3 pm. Please take advantage of the available on-line services to help keep the line short in the office during high season.

If you have a brand new registration for a boat, car, golf cart or trailer, please try to come during the

week when the office is not as busy. Call ahead to be sure you have all the proper documents and discuss with the office staff the possibility of an appointment time to complete the new registrations. A new registration can take more than an hour and you may be asked to leave copies of your documents for the registration to be completed and picked up later in the day or another day. **Please note the office will be closed Sat., July 4th, 2015.**

To pay the toll on the ferry you need an E-Z Ride card, a paper ticket, an emailed ticket, or a picture of the E-Z ride card. The ferry employees are not responsible to type in numbers or take verbal requests to use another party's card for passage in any situation. Please provide family, guests, and any vendors you have with one of the above tools for ferry passage.

NIXLE

Our NIXLE system is up and running. This system will notify all subscribers of important / emergency notices in their selected areas via text, web, and email. The best part of this is that it is a free service to both the municipality and to residents as well. We can initiate notices to all Islanders that subscribe to

the service. However, in order to access the notices you will be required to subscribe. You can subscribe by going to their website at www.nixle.com and following the prompts. I would encourage everyone to subscribe to this service. It is an ideal way to be notified of issues that may affect your time on the Island

Mailing Addresses

In October of 2014 I requested a new Zip Code from the USPS. The request was denied on January 7, 2015. At this point, please continue to use your lot numbers for your mailing address. We are presently working with the Postmaster in Windham to reach a logical solution.

New Signs (E911 numbers)

The DPW is presently installing the new numbers on Town property. Please do not move these signs after the installation. The signs are the property of the Town of Frye Island. These new NG 911 signs are standardized and placed a certain way at a designated height for a reason. Even though a sign has been installed, there may be some changes to your number as numbering issues get resolved.

Package delivery protocol

All packages delivered by any courier service (UPS, FEDEX, etc.) will be delivered to the Post Office by 7 am the following day. You are responsible to track your own deliveries. If you have a package that is perishable, medicine, overnight delivery you have the right to free pedestrian passage to collect your package at the Ferry trailer once you track and it states delivered.

Fireworks

The Frye Island fireworks display is scheduled for July 4th Saturday evening. Your **Contributions** for the show are greatly appreciated.

The fireworks will be off Long Beach on Saturday night the 4th at dusk. (8:45-9:15)

Reminder: if you have a boat in the Long Beach Marina in slip # 84 through #130 on the lake side or #67 through #131 on the causeway side, your boat **MUST BE MOVED** by 5PM to allow the pyro technicians the time to set up the display safely. Even if you don't have to move your boat and you are planning on viewing the fireworks from the lake, you must be out of the marina by 5 PM as well. The marina will reopen immediately following the fireworks display. In the event that poor weather postpones the event as it did last year a sign will be placed on the bulletin board.

Variable Milfoil

Presently the Long Beach Marina and two other sites in the Quail Circle area have variable milfoil. The Town has taken steps to construct a DASH machine (Diver Assisted Suction Harvester). Our diver Mr. Larry Pilotte has advised us that with this equipment he will remove three times the amount per shift. He is asking for volunteers to assist him with this worthy project.

Larry's comment: **Volunteers in helping with eradication of milfoil are greatly needed. Most of the work would be done on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Time frame 9:30am - 2:00pm. Assisting diver in bagging. Walking shoreline and picking up loose fragments. If you have kayak available, gathering floating fragments is needed. Creating a "milfoil team" will ensure to control this invasive nightmare.**

Free Blood Pressure Check, First Aid

As high season gets closer the Towns EMS service will be offering courtesy blood pressure checks. This service will be offered Monday through Friday 10:00am to Noon at the Ferry Landing Rescue Barn next to the Post Office. Please stop by and say hi to the EMTs that will be working on the island this summer.

Also offered at no charge will be routine first aid. So for anyone that has an injury that needs attention, stop by the Rescue Barn and have the on duty EMT take a look at your situation, or **call 893-2810** for non-emergency, **911 for emergency** and we'll come to you. As always, all patient care offered by Frye Island EMS will be at no charge, you will not get a bill.

Would I do this at home.....?
